## A Knitted Waistcoat

### BACK

#### Shape Shoulders

*The last instruction to place the remaining stitches on a stitch holder is incomplete, and does not give information regarding the shoulder stitches.*

*Work the remaining stitches as presented on needles as follows to fit in with later instructions.*

*With WS facing, cast off 27 (35, 39, 43, 47, 50) sts for first shoulder, fastening off final stitch and breaking yarn.*

*Place next 41 (43, 53, 61, 71, 81) sts on a stitch holder for back neck.*

*Rejoin yarn to remaining 27 (35, 39, 43, 47, 50) sts for second shoulder, and work in rib to end of row. Then with RS facing, cast off remaining sts.*
