#### **GAUGE**

Needle size is incorrect and should read:

We obtained this gauge using 3.25mm needles.

#### SIZING AND FINISHING GUIDE

The following length measurements are incorrect and should read:

#### **BACK**

Final paragraph before Shape Armholes should read:

These 2 rows form pattern. Repeat these 2 rows until work measures 28 (29, 30, 31, 33) cm (11, 11½, 12, 12½, 13¼ in).

### Shape armholes

Final paragraph before Divide for Neck should read:

Maintaining patt, continue without shaping *until work measures approx 14½ (15½, 16½, 17½, 19½) cm (5¾, 6¼, 6½, 7, 7¾ in).* 

## **Divide for Neck**

The instructions here should read:

**Next row** (RS): Patt 16 (19, 19, 23, 23) and transfer these sts on to a stitch holder, then cast off *next 33 (35, 35, 39, 39) sts,* patt to end, turn and work on these rem 16 (19, 19, 23, 23) sts.



## **Left Back**

The stitch count after the decreases is incorrect, and should read:

\*\* Continue in patt as set, and dec 1 st at neck edge of next and 6 foll alt rows; 9 (12, 12, 16, 16) sts.

#### **JABOT** (Worked Sideways)

The first of the Next row instructions doesn't take into account the stitch remaining after casting off when aligning the pattern, and should read:

**Next row**: Cast off *35 sts, \* k1, p1;* rep from \* to end of row; 71 (75, 87, 99, 115) sts.
