BACK

Shape Armholes

The shape armholes instructions should read:

*Maintaining patt, cast off 4 (5, 7, 7, 7, 7, 8) sts at beg of next 2 (4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4) rows, 108 (116, 128, 128, 164, 180, 196) sts.
Work 1 row in rib.*

1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th sizes only

Next row (Dec): Work 2 sts tog, rib to last 2 sts, work 2 sts tog; 2 sts dec.

Next row: Rib to end.

Rep these last 2 rows a further 3 (5, 9, 7) times more, 100 (104, 108, 112) sts.

5th, 6th & 7th sizes only

Next row (Dec): Work 3 sts tog, rib to last 3 sts, work 3 sts tog; 4 sts dec.

Next row: Rib to end.

Rep these last 2 rows a further 10 (13, 15) times more; 120 (124, 132) sts.

**** All sizes*

Continue

The last paragraph in this section is unchanged.

FRONT

As a result, the front instructions should read:

*Work exactly as for back until *** and you have 100 (104, 108, 112, 120, 124, 132) sts.*

Maintaining patt, work straight for 32 (30, 26, 34, 36, 32, 30) rows.

Divide for Neck

The first two sentences should read:

Rib 26 (28, 30, 32, 36, 38, 42) sts then transfer these sts onto a stitch holder. Cast off centre 48 sts, rib 26 (28, 30, 32, 36, 38, 42) sts.

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
