Sizing

Finished Measurements

Finished length measurements do not include rib, and should read:

Finished length 51 (20½) 52 (20¾) 56 (22½) 57 (22¾) 62 (24¾)

PATTERN NOTES

Frilly Lace Pattern (also shown on chart)

Row 11 included extra text, and should read:

Row 11: P3, K2tog, YO, P3, * K9, P2, K9, P3, K2tog, YO, P3, rep from * to end of row.

BACK

Shape Armholes

The last sentence should read:

Work without shaping until armhole measures 18 (19, 20, 21, 23) cm (7, 7½, 8, 8½, 9 in) ending with a WS row.

FRONT

Shape Shoulder

Shoulder instructions for Right Front should read:

Cast off 8 (9, 9, 10, 10) sts at beg of next row and 1 (1, 1, 1, 2) foll alt rows, *then cast off remaining 7 (7, 8, 8, –) sts at beg of next alt row.*

Left Front

Shape Shoulder

Shoulder instructions for Left Front should read:

Cast off 8 (9, 9, 10, 10) sts at beg of next row and 1 (1, 1, 1, 2) foll alt rows, *then cast off remaining 7 (7, 8, 8, –) sts at beg of next alt row.*

SLEEVES (MAKE TWO)

To give sufficient stitches to work main pattern as instructed, the increase row should read:

Next row (Inc): *Patt 10 (20, 30, 36, 32), [Kfb] 50 (40, 30, 38, 56) times, patt 10 (20, 30, 36, 32); 120 (120, 120, 148, 176) sts.*

Shape Sleeve Head

Sleeve Head instructions should read:

Cast off 6 (6, 8, 10, 12) sts at beg of next 4 (8, 8, 8, 8) rows; 96 (72, 56, 68, 80) sts. Then dec 1 st at each end of every 2nd [4th, 8th, 4th, 4th] row, 17 (5, 5, 11, 9) times, then dec 1 st at each end of every 1st [2nd, 6th, 2nd, 2nd] row, 10 (10, 2, 2, 10) times; 42 sts. Cast off rem 42 sts.
