## BACK

Final paragraph before Shape Armholes should read:
Maintaining patt, inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th (5th, 5th, 5th) row, a further 12 times; 111 (119, $127,135)$ sts. Work $11(3,9,13)$ rows without shaping.

## Shape Shoulders

For 4th size only, first paragraph of this section should read:
Maintaining patt, cast off $11(11,11,14)$ sts at beg of next $2(6,2,2)$ rows, then cast off $10(-, 12,13)$ sts at beg of next $4(-, 4,4)$ rows; $31(33,35,37)$ sts.

## FRONT

Final paragraph before Shape Armholes should read:
Maintaining patt, inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th (5th, 5th, 5th) row, a further 12 times; 123 (131, $139,147)$ sts. Work $11(3,9,13)$ rows without shaping.

## Divide for neck

For 1st size, there are insufficient rows for the front opening, and the last paragraph of this paragraph should read: Repeat 3rd row until you have worked $39(47,47,47)$ rows in moss st altogether, ending with a RS row, at centre edge.

## Shape Shoulders

First paragraph of this section should read:
Maintaining patt, cast off $11(12,11,14)$ sts at beg of row, then cast off $10(11,13,13)$ sts at beg of 2 foll alt rows; $31(33,35,37)$ sts.

Then the instructions following Buttonhole Row 2 need adjusting to work fewer rows between buttonholes for the 1st size, and should read:
Work another 8 (10, 10, 10) rows in moss st.
Repeat last $10(12,12,12)$ rows twice more, then rep the buttonhole rows only, once.
Sleeves
Second sentence should read:
Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 6th row, a further 6 times; $77(85,91,95)$ sts.
