A Stitch in Time Volume 2, 2013 (second edition) pages 120–127 Single Pattern: SC060 20150913; published: 2015

Please note, corrections or additional information are shown in red italics.

Where edits apply to a particular version, this will be indicated by ASIT2 only or Single Pattern only.

RIGHT FRONT

Row instruction reworded, omitting instruction to work the first stitch after casting off as this stitch has already been worked.

Row 3: K2, p1, cast off 2 sts, * p1, k1; repeat from * to end.

Shape Armhole

ASIT2 only, second paragraph should read:

Continuing to maintain patt as set (now repeating marked section 3 (3, 4, 4, 5) times) and working buttonholes as required, work 26 (16, 36, 36, 36) rows in patt thus ending on *chart line 6 (16, 6, 6, 16)*; (63, 63, 79, 79, 95 sts).

LEFT FRONT

Single Pattern only, last paragraph before Armhole Shaping should read: Last 2 rows set edge sts and chart. Work as set until line 8 (8, 18, 18, 8) of chart has been worked for the 4th (3rd, 5th, 4th, 5th time); (79, 79, 95, 95, 111 sts).

Shape Armhole

Second paragraph should read:

Continuing to maintain patt as set (now repeating marked section 3 (3, 4, 4, 5) times), work 26 (16, 36, 36, 36) rows in patt thus ending on *chart line 15 (5, 15, 15, 5)*; (63, 63, 79, 79, 95 sts).

BACK

Shape Armholes

Row instructions reworded, adjusting cast-off numbers to take yarn overs into account and omitting instruction to work the first stitch after casting off as this stitch has already been worked. For ASIT2 only, note that specific row instructions are also given for each size.

1st, 2nd and 5th sizes only

Next row (RS): Cast off 17 sts in patt, yo, * C9F, yo, p7, yo; rep from * to last 6 sts, k4, p1, k1; (134, 134, –, –, 206 sts).

Next row (WS): Cast off 18 sts in patt, k1, p4, * k9, p4, k1, p4; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2; (116, 116, –, –, 188 sts).

3rd and 4th sizes only

Next row (RS): Cast off 16 sts in patt, k5 * yo, p7, yo, C9F; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1; (-, -, 170, 170, - sts). Next row (WS): Cast off 18 sts in patt, k1, * p4, k1, p4, k9; rep from * to last 6 sts, p4, k2; (-, -, 152, 152, - sts).

BACK

Shape Armholes

All sizes

Corrections to stitch counts for 3rd and 4th sizes mean this section should read:

Whilst maintaining pattern and edge sts as set (now working marked section 6 (6, 8, 8, 10) times), work 25 (15, 35, 35, 35) rows in patt thus ending on chart line 5 (15, 5, 5, 15); (104, 104, *138, 138,* 168 sts). Divide for back neck as folls:

Next row (WS): Patt 23 (23, *33*, *33*, 41) sts, cast off centre 58 (58, *72*, *72*, 86) sts, patt to end. Working on last 23 (23, *33*, *33*, 41) sts only, work in patt for a further 15 (19, 15, 15, 25) rows, thus ending with chart line 1 (15, 1, 1, 1).

Shape Shoulder

Corrections to stitch counts for 3rd and 4th sizes mean second paragraph should read: With RS facing, rejoin yarn at neck edge and work on rem 23 (23, 33, 33, 41) sts in patt for a further 16 (20, 16, 16, 26) rows thus ending on chart line 2 (16, 2, 2, 2).

YOKE

Row instructions are reworded, omitting instruction to work the first stitch after casting off as this stitch has already been worked.

Row 6: K2, p1, *cast off 2 sts*, *p1*, *[k1*, *p1] 14 (14, 18, 18, 21) times*, [k1, p2tog] twice, [k1, p1] 16 (16, 16, 16, 21) times, [k1, p2tog] twice, [k1, p1] 25 (25, 32, 32, 39) times, [k1, p2tog] twice, [k1, p1] 16 (16, 16, 16, 21) times, [k1, p2tog] twice, [k1, p1] 17 (17, 21, 21, 24) times, k1; (199, 199, 229, 229, 275 sts).

The next affected row is the first of the two Next row instructions:

Next row (WS): K2, p1, *cast off 2 sts, p1, [k1, p1] 11 (11, 15, 15, 18) times,* [k1, p2tog] twice, [k1, p1] 10 (10, 10, 10, 15) times, [k1, p2tog] twice, [k1, p1] 19 (19, 26, 26, 33) times, [k1, p2tog] twice, [k1, p1] 10 (10, 10, 10, 15) times, [k1, p2tog] twice, [k1, p1] 14 (14, 18, 18, 21) times, k2; (151, 151, 181, 181, 227 sts).

SLEEVES

Having worked the rib and the following increase row (Next row), the next paragraph should read: Change to 3.25 (3.75, 3.25, 3.75, 3.25) mm needles and work chart and edge sts as set for back, repeating marked section 4 (4, 5, 5, 6) times, until line 12 of chart has been worked for the first time; (72, 72, 88, 88, 104 sts). Having worked Rows 1 and 2, the next paragraph should read:

Cont to work as set *and working increased stitches in reverse stocking stitch*, inc 1 st at each end of chart row 19 and on 13 foll 6th rows. Then work 3 rows without shaping (last row should be line 20 of chart); *(110, 110, 128, 128, 146 sts)*.
