CHARTS

In all charts, while the oxo motifs are placed correctly and the placement instructions read correctly, the peerie motifs are offset by 1 stitch. To align the patterning, when working the peerie motifs only, use the following instructions for Body and Sleeves.

BODY

Chart Placement

For all peerie motif rounds, instead of working full repeats of the chart at start and end of rounds, start working with chart stitch 2, and end all peerie motif rounds with chart stitch 1.

SLEEVES

Women's / Shorter Sleeve

Men's / Longer Sleeve

These edits apply to all instructions under these three headings.

For all peerie motif rounds, wherever instructions state a stitch to start with, instead start with the st following. For example, in the instruction stating Commencing with st 15 (15, 8, 22, 22, 8, 8), *peerie motifs start with st 16 (16, 9, 23, 23, 9, 9).*
