BACK

Shape Armholes

Replaces second sentence of the Back: Shaping Armhole section on page 2. Dec one st at each armhole edge of next and every foll RS row 2 (5, 7, 10, 4, 8, 10, 14, 16) times, 72 (72, 76, 76, 80, 80, 84, 84, 88) sts.

Edits to the following section make the rib symmetrical across the decrease points, improving the appearance of the rib. Note that the method uses removable stitch markers which were not included in the pattern materials section.

NECK BAND

Using 3.25mm circular needle, commencing at start of held sts at back and with RS facing, rejoin yarn to sts on holder. Work as follows: K56 sts from holder for back neck. Place removable markers on first and last sts, pick up and K 50 (54, 58, 62, 62, 66, 70, 74, 78) sts down left side neck, K56 sts from holder for front neck. Place removable markers on first and last sts, pick up and K 50 (54, 58, 62, 62, 66, 70, 74, 78) sts up right side neck, 212 (220, 228, 236, 236, 244, 252, 260, 268) sts.

The neck band is worked in the round from this point.

Next round: (K1, * P2, K2, rep from * to within 3 sts of marked st, P2, K1, P marked st) 4 times. **Dec round:** (Patt to within 1 st of marked st, SI1, P2tog, psso) 4 times, 8 sts decreased.

Now maintaining in patt as set, dec 2 sts at each corner of every row until a further 10 rows have been worked, 88 sts decreased in total, 124 (132, 140, 148, 148, 156, 164, 172, 180) sts. Cast off loosely in rib, changing to a larger needle for cast-off round if necessary.



VERSION PUBLISHED 2016: WORKED FLAT (PAGE 2)

If you work Blanche flat, the Front, Shape Armhole instructions listed on page 2 are for the Left Armhole followed by the Right Armhole.

BACK

Shape Armholes

Replaces second sentence of the Back: Shaping Armhole section on page 2. Dec one st at each armhole edge of next and every foll RS row 2 (5, 7, 10, 4, 8, 10, 14, 16) times, 72 (72, 76, 76, 80, 80, 84, 84, 88) sts.

BODY

Divide for Armholes and Back Neck

When working this section, you have started the armhole decreases before switching to the Shape Armhole sections on page 2. To avoid working too many decreases, work the Shape Armhole sections as follows.

FRONT

Shape Armhole (Right Front)

Replaces first paragraph of the second Front: Shaping Armhole section on page 2, bottom of first column.

Next row (WS): Maintaining patt, cast off -(-, -, -, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6) sts at beg of foll -(-, -, -, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1) row.

Knit one row then dec one st at armhole edge of next and every foll WS row 2 (5, 7, 10, 4, 8, 10, 14, 16) times, 8 (8, 10, 10, 12, 12, 14, 14, 16) sts rem.

Shape Armhole (Left Front)

Replaces first paragraph of the first Front: Shaping Armhole section on page 2, halfway down the first column.

Next row (RS): *Maintaining patt, cast off – (–, –, –, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6) sts at beg of foll – (–, –, –, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1) RS row.*Purl one row then dec one st at each armhole edge of next and every foll RS row 2 (5, 7, 10, 4, 8, 10, 14, 16) times, 8 (8, 10, 10, 12, 12, 14, 14, 16) sts rem.

BACK

Shape Armholes

Replaces first paragraph of the Back: Shaping Armhole section on page 2, top of second column. Maintaining patt, cast off - (-, -, -, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6) sts at beg of next - (-, -, -, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) rows. Dec one st at each armhole edge of next and every foll RS row 2 (5, 7, 10, 4, 8, 10, 14, 16) times, 72 (72, 76, 76, 80, 80, 84, 84, 88) sts.
