PATTERN NOTES

This instruction is not included in single pattern, but may be useful to refer to. Instructions for alternate cable caston should read:

I recommend casting on using the alternate cable cast-on method to create a ribbed cast on which provides additional stretch. Begin with a slip knot, *knit* into the slip knot and place new st onto same needle, *purl* between slip knot and *knit* st, and place new st on needle, *knit* between *knit* st and *purl* st and place new st on needle. Continue in this manner alternately casting on first with a *knit* st followed by a *purl* st. When casting on an even number of sts your last cast-on st will be a *knit* st.

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BRIM

This edit relates to the end of the first paragraph, which should read: Change to 3mm circular needle.

Next round (Inc): K - (1, 2), * kfb, k1; rep from * to last - (1, 2) sts, k - (1, 2); 210 (224, 238) sts. K 3 rounds.

BOTH VERSIONS

This edit relates to the last two decrease rounds which apply to all three sizes, starting towards the bottom of the first column on p304 in A Stitch In Time Vol 1, or p3 of the single pattern. These should read:

Next round (Dec): *Using A only, k 7 (-, 7), * k2tog, k 1 (2, 2); rep from * to last 7 (-, 7) sts, k 7 (-, 7); 70 (84, 98)*

Next round (Dec): K 3 (-, 14), * k2tog, k 1 (1, -); rep from * to last 4 (-, 14) sts, k 4 (-, 14); 49 (56, 63) sts.

1st size only

Next round (Dec): K 3, * k2tog, rep from * to last 4 sts, k4; 28 sts.
