Diamonds are Forever

Single Pattern: SCCK01 20151024

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Please note, corrections or additional information are shown in red italics.

There is a discrepancy in the needle sizes listed in the Materials section and the pattern instructions.

For larger needles, the pattern lists the following needle sizes:

MATERIALS

3mm (US 3) circular needles (80–100cm in length)

Set of 3mm (US 3) DPNs

TENSION

30 sts & 38 rows = 10cm (4in) using 3mm needles over stocking stitch in the round.

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS: BODY, SLEEVES AND YOKE

Larger needles are listed as 3.25mm throughout.

SUGGESTED NEEDLES AND ACHIEVING GAUGE

Based on pattern gauge and the yarn used, the sample was most probably knitted using size 3mm needles.

When following any knitting pattern, use the needles specified as a guide only. Work a swatch, or if necessary, a series of swatches to determine which needle size YOU NEED to use to achieve the given tension or gauge. It is more important to achieve the specified gauge or tension than use the needle size specified in the pattern.

Regardless of whether size 3mm or 3.25mm needles are specified in the pattern, use the needle size YOU NEED to achieve the given gauge or tension.
