

Lady's Evening Jumper

Single Pattern: SC015 20181015 Published: 2018

Please note, corrections or additional information are shown in red italics.

LACE PATTERN

The charts for this pattern do not include size specific detail for the first few stitches at the start and end of rows. Please be aware that when working the start and end of all rows, care is needed to make sure the number of lace decreases matches the number of yarn overs to maintain stitch counts. This applies to straight sections of the garment as well as sections with shaping.

Where an extra decrease or yarn over from the lace chart occurs at the start or end of a row, work a knit stitch instead.

FRONT

Front Darts

Further information regarding the first dart row, is provided for clarification. When working this row, note that the 34 sts marked in red italics below include the stitch already on the right hand needle from the previous cast-off.

Next row (RS): Maintaining patt as set, work 18 (27, 35, 45, 54) sts, then cast off the following 17 sts, continuing to maintain patt work a further 34 sts, then cast off the following 16 sts, then work in pattern as set to end of row.
