Little Angel

Single Pattern: SC043 20140626

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Please note, corrections or additional information are shown in red italics.

The Little Angel sweater is a reversible garment, and can be worn with the opening at either the back or the front. However, where use of both back and front would cause confusion, the pattern instructions are written for a front opening; corrections are provided below for sections where back and front were switched.

Alternative instructions for knitting Lower Body in one piece

To fit in with use of back and front in the underarm shaping and yoke instructions which follow, Round 1 should read:

Round 1 (RS): K 33 (35, 38, 39, 41) *for right front*, PM, k 66 (69, 75, 58, 81) *for back*, PM, and k 33 (35, 38, 39, 41) *for left front*.

Alternative instructions for knitting Lower Body in one piece

Shape Armholes

To fit in with use of back and front in the underarm shaping and yoke instructions which follow, Next Row should read:

Next Row (RS): K 31 (33, 34, 35, 37), cast off next 4 (4, 8, 8, 8) sts, knit until you have 62 (65, 67, 70, 73) sts on needle after cast-off sts, cast off next 4 (4, 8, 8, 8) sts, k to end. You now have two set of 31 (33, 34, 35, 37) sts for *each side of the front*, as well as 62 (65, 67, 70, 73) sts *for the back*. In the following section you will work back and forth on each set separately.

MAKING UP

Second sentence should read:

Using 2mm crochet hook, work 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) button loops by working 8 chain sts on appropriate side of *front/back opening*.
